Judge's Report, Syrian Classes, Mapplewell 14th December 2024

I enjoyed judging some beautiful hamsters at Mapplewell and also the lovely Christmassy atmosphere. Many thanks to my book steward Anastasia Blair and pen steward Catherine Mason and also show secretary Margaret Donnelly. A lot of hamsters showed signs of moult with some colours lacking richness. Please ensure you check your pens are in good condition. It's not nice to lose a place as you put your hamster in a shoddy pen. Also grooming of long-coats before benching. We had a long-haired male with matts so bad they needed to be cut out as they were pulling on the skin. There were however some beautiful hamsters to judge and my class winners were:

- **SH Golden –** (Pen 101) Decent head and type. Uneven, patchy ticking. Lacks richness. WOCB. *71.5*, *6 entries*
- SH Cream (Pen 202) A lovely handsome male with deep colour and dense coat as well as good type and lovely head. COM and RBIS. 75, 6 entries
- **SH AOC male** (Pen 303) Melanistic Yellow. Lovely type and head. Some browning. *73.5, 4 entries*
- SH AOC female (Pen 404) Dark Grey. Decent type and colour. STBF, some browning but good undercoat colour. 72, 4 entries
- SH Pattern (Pen 505) Cinnamon tort & white. Ragged but complete band. Needs more yellow. Decent type. 73, 5 entries
- SH Satin (Pen 603) Golden, Nice type and head. Patchy ticking. 72.5, 3 entries
- **LH Cream** (Pen 702) BEC female, nice type. Lovely deep colour and even length of coat. 74, 4 entries
- LH AOC male (Pen 903) Golden. Decent type and head. Colour lacked richness. Ragged skirt. 72.5, 3 entries
- **LH Patterned** (Pen 1101) Sable Banded F. I've judged this hamster before and my she has never aged or changed and is still one of the most beautiful hamsters I've ever seen. Gorgeous type, firm bodied and a good size with even coat length and an excellent band. **COM and BIS** which I believe makes her a Grand Champion. 81, 3 entries
- LH Satin (Pen 1201) Golden. Nice head and decent rich colour though lacked ticking. 71, 1 entries
- Rex (Pen 1302) BEC. Good head. Nice coat texture and curl on the whiskers 73, 3 entries

Judge's Report, Dwarf Classes, Mapplewell 14th December 2024

Judging as part of the Christmas show was fun. Thanks to Susan who book and pen stewarded. There were 33 hamsters entered – considering only six of those were female it was good to see that three of them won their class!

D1 Normal Campbell – 1 entry – This was a nice friendly female. She had a fairly open coat which didn't do anything for her top colour! She had good arches and under colour but a slightly short stripe. Thin fur on chest and belly cost her points.

D2 AOC Campbell – 4 entries – (all opal) This male had a lovely even colour with good well defined arches and an extremely long dorsal stripe. He had a lovely masculine head set onto decent neck and flowing into a good body shape. He had thin fur on chest and slightly long toe nails. He was in good solid bodily condition. Reserve BIS and was awarded a COM.

D5 Normal Winter White – 6 entries – The class was won by a pleasing female. She had a good top and under colour and had three neat arches and an ok stripe. She had such a pretty face and was the correct shape. She lost on condition as she had quite long toe nails. She was calm to handle

D6 Sapphire Winter White – 2 entries – This male was a nice even colour with the correct three arches; his stripe was a bit short and he had a fair amount of white on his tummy. He had quite bulgy eyes and some long nails.

D7 Pearl Winter White – 5 entries – A pretty sapphire pearl female won this class. She was slightly heavily shaded over the rump but lightly and evenly ticked on the rest of the body. She had a nice thick top coat but had slightly thin fur on the chest. She was the correct shape in body and head. She had a wonderful calm temperament.

D8 Normal Chinese – 3 entries – A nice male won this class. He had good size, condition and type; his fur was plush with lovely roll back. His colour was even with light ticking and clean crisp clear demarcation lines.

D9 Dominant Spot Chinese – 4 entries – The class was won by my eventual BIS winner. He lacked spots, but what he lost on pattern, he more than made up for on colour, this being a rich even shade. His fur was dense with that wonderful roll back, and had a lovely solid body and was a great size. He had a lovely masculine head with good profile. A quality hamster! I understand that this COM made him into a Grand Champion – well done! **D10 Black Eyed White Chinese – 3 entries –** The class was won by a solid well-built male who was clean and had a gleaming coat. He was easy to handle.

D21 Non-Standard – 3 entries – The winner was a nice type marbled winter white. He had an open coat and slightly thin chest fur. He was in firm bodily condition. He looked like a more mature hamster. He narrowly beat the lovely young sapphire Chinese who was second.
